

PROGRAMMA DI LINGUA E CULTURA INGLESE

1) IN CLASS

Grammar: to be, subject pronouns, possessive adjectives, this/that/these/those, possessive's, a/an, plural nouns, imperative, can/can't/prepositions, there is/there are, have got.

Vocabulary: the alphabet, numbers, family members, countries and nationalities, classroom language, age, colours, adjectives, objects, abilities, rooms and furniture, gadgets, days of the week, months and seasons, times, ordinal numbers.

2) FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Grammar: Present simple: affirmative/interrogative/negative; Whquestions; Adverbs of frequency. Vocabulary: Free time and routines; Collocations – have, go and play; Verb + noun collocations; Verb+ preposition collocations.

Functions: Descriptions of free-time activities. Talking about preferences. Stating an opinion.

3) FOOD

Grammar: Countable and uncountable nouns; some and any; much, many and a lot of. Articles. Vocabulary: Food and drink; Food containers; Phrases related to food; In a supermarket.

Functions: Ordering food. Culture Focus: English as a Lingua Franca, New Englishes, English on the Internet

4) WORK

Grammar: Present Continuous; Present Simple vs present Continuous.

Vocabulary: Jobs and work; Jobs with suffixes; Collocations – job and work; work + preposition. Functions: Descriptions of jobs; Describing a photo.

5) PEOPLE

Grammar: Comparative and superlative adjectives; Have to/don't have to.

Vocabulary: Appearance; Adjective order; Personality adjectives.

Functions: Description of appearance and personality; Shopping for clothes. Culture Focus: The United Kingdom; London; Ireland/Eire; Dublin; The USA; New York.

6) EDUCATION

Grammar: Must/mustn't; Should/shouldn't; Past Simple: was/were, could.

Vocabulary: Schools; Objects, subjects and people at school; Phrases about school; Collocations – do, get and be.

Functions: Describing school activities.

7) SPORT AND HEALTH

Grammar: Past Simple: affirmative, interrogative and negative.. Vocabulary: Types of sport; Health; Collocations – do, go and play; Collocations – sport and health.

Functions: Description of an event; Asking and giving advice.

Culture Focus: People in the UK; People in the USA.

8) NATURE

Grammar: Future with will/be going to and Present Continuous.

Vocabulary: Landscape; Wildlife; Environmental problems.

Functions: Agreeing and disagreeing.

9) TRAVEL

Grammar: Present perfect with never/ever; Present Perfect vs Past Simple; Present Perfect with just/already/yet..

Vocabulary: Holiday and transport; Accommodation; Collocations – journeys and holidays.

Functions: Asking and giving directions. Culture Focus: A Planet and its Elements; Global Warming
