- 1) Grammar: Imperative – To be – Subject pronouns – Demonstrative pronouns – Plural nouns – Possessive adjectives – Possessive's – Can/Can't – Prepositions – There is/There are – Have got
 - Vocabulary: Alphabet, Classroom language, Numbers, Countries and nationalities, Age, Colours, Adjectives, Objects, Family, Abilities, Rooms and furniture, Gadgets, Days of the week, Months and seasons, Times, Ordinal numbers
 - Functions: Asking for and giving personal information – Understanding and using classroom language – Giving instructions – Making suggestions – Talking about abilities and possessions – Asking and answering questions about family – Asking and telling the time

 - Grammar: Present Simple – Adverbs of frequency
 - Vocabulary: Free time and routine activities
 - Functions: Talking about free time activities and routines, facts, routines, likes and dislikes – Expressing preferences Literature and Culture Focus: “Main trends in contemporary family life”
- 3) **“FOOD”**
 - Grammar: Countable and Uncountable Nouns – Singular and plural – Quantifiers: some, any, much, many and a lot – Articles: a/an, the and no article Vocabulary: Food in a supermarket – Food containers
 - Functions: Talking about the food people like and don't like – Talking about quantity – Ordering food and drink in a café Literature and Culture Focus: “Fictitious dishes” by Dinah Fried
- 4) **“WORK”**

Grammar: Present Continuous – Present Simple and Present Continuous

Vocabulary: Jobs

Functions: Talking about jobs and work – Talking about actions happening at the time of speaking – Describing photos Literature and Culture Focus: “Working in the UK”
- 5) **“PEOPLE”**

Grammar: Comparatives and Superlatives Vocabulary: Appearance – Personality adjectives

Functions: Describing and comparing people – Talking about important events in people's life, clothes and obligation – Shopping for clothes Literature and Culture Focus: “Celebr8” by Levi Tafari
- 6) **“EDUCATION”**

Grammar: Must/Mustn't – Should/Shouldn't – Past Simple: was/were, Could Vocabulary: Schools – Classroom objects – School subjects – People at school

Functions: Talking about schools and rules – Giving advice – Talking about the past – Asking for information to organise a school trip Literature and Culture Focus: “Education in the UK” – “Education in the USA”
- 7) **“SPORT AND HEALTH”**

Grammar: Past Simple of regular and irregular verbs Vocabulary: Types of sports - Health

Functions: Talking about sport and health – Describing past events – Expressing an opinion
– Asking for and giving advice about healthy lifestyle Literature and Culture Focus: "I fell
in love with football from Fever Pitch by Nick Hornby"

8) "NATURE"

Grammar: Future with will – Future with be going to and Present Continuous

Vocabulary: Landscape – Wildlife – Environmental problems

Functions: Talking about the wildlife and the countryside – Talking and predicting future
events .- Talking about plans – Agreeing and disagreeing Literature and Culture Focus:
"Nature in poetry: poems by Emily Dickinson"

9) "TRAVEL"

Grammar: Present Perfect with ever/never, just/yet/already – Present Perfect and Past
Simple - Vocabulary: Holiday and transport - Accommodation Functions: Talking about
holiday and transport, actions that happened some time in the past – Asking for and giving
directions – Expressing agreement and disagreement Literature and Culture Focus: "Great
Britain: Your ideal destination"
